
The work on the new playground is progressing well and I think it will be an amazing space for the children once it is completed. Please continue to park considerately when dropping and collecting your children.

Important Notice: Respecting Our Neighbours at the Music Hub

We've been informed by our neighbours at the Music Hub, located off Marsden Road between the library and the car wash, that they have experienced several issues since the start of term due to families blocking their driveway during drop-off and pick-up times.

Cars are being left unattended for over 10 minutes, preventing their staff from accessing important meetings, lessons, and engagements. Staff have unfortunately also experienced some unkind behaviour when they have asked people to move their cars.

Please can you avoid parking on or blocking the Music Hub's driveway when collecting or dropping off your child(ren) at Beacon View Primary. Their staff require constant access to their offices, especially for accessibility reasons and transporting equipment.

As a reminder, the gate half way along the alleyway between Allaway Avenue and Cheltenham Road can be used for access to school.
